

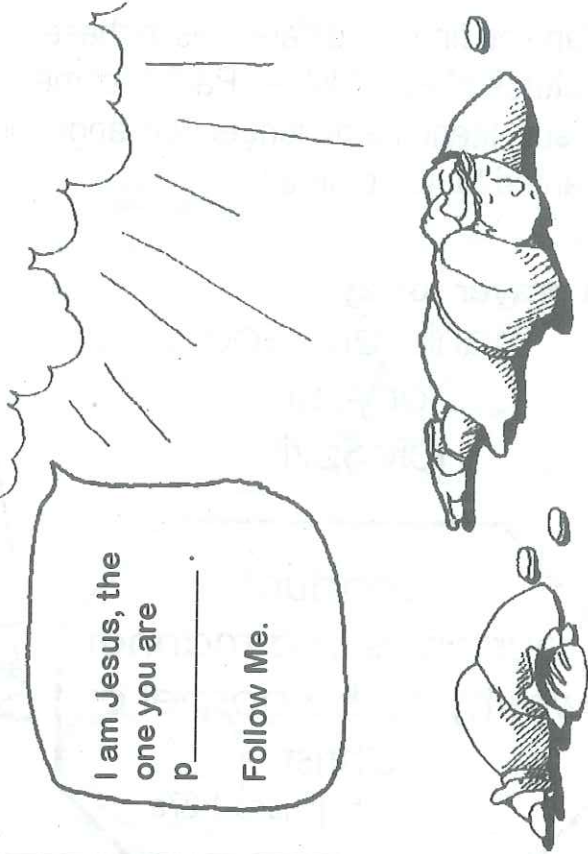

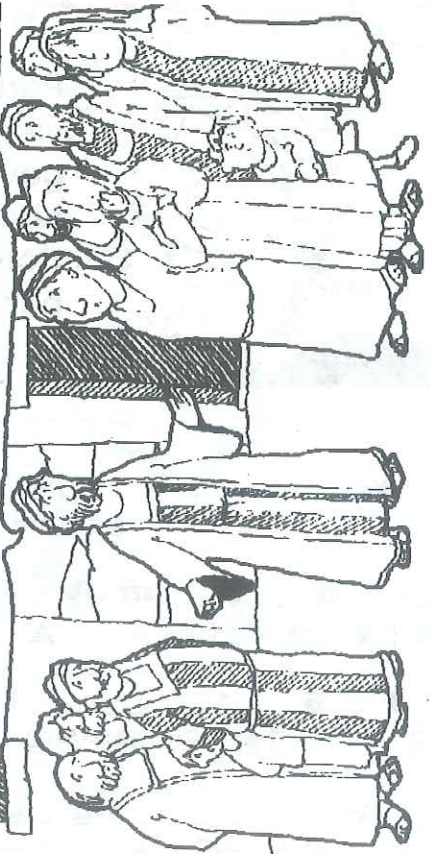

Can you find the differences in these pictures of Paul? When Paul became Jesus' friend he no longer was angry or wanted to hurt others.

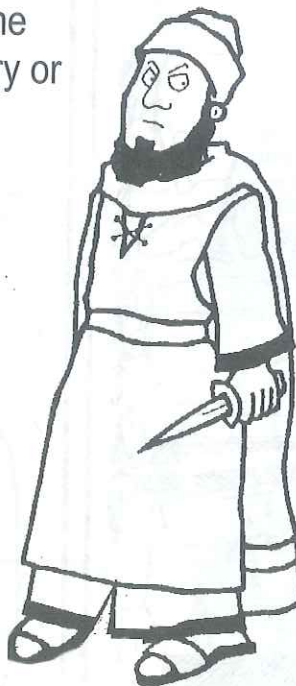
